+ <b>Working Against Cancer: Jackie Maas Memorial Scholarship</b>	

**Deadline** – “Postmarked by” indicates that for the application to be considered it must be postmarked by the date given. If only a date is given, then the scholarship provider must receive the application by that date.

**Age Range:** Specific cutoff ages will be indicated, otherwise age ranges refers to general students that may apply to the “Type of Education” indicated, as explained below.

**Specific Location** – Residents of designated geographic locations such as counties or states are eligible to apply.

**Education Type:** *Undergraduate* refers to all two and four year universities, community college program, and vocation or technical schools. *General Higher Education* refers to undergraduate programs (as indicated above) as well as graduate schools, medical and law schools, and other specific graduate programs. *Other* is always specifically explained, generally refers to a cash award.

**Notes:** Lists special considerations of the scholarship or scholarship provider, and indicates scholarship renewal policies.
